1949: February 19 REVEREND ARTHUR L. MASSICOTTE, Founding Pastor

Born: February 19, 1905, in Manchester, New Hampshire

February 1, 1949

Reverend A. L. Massicotte St. Charles' Orphanage Rochester, N.H.

Dear Father Massicotte:

You are hereby appointed Pastor of the newly formed English speaking parish of St. Joseph in Belmont. You will take possession of this parish on Saturday, February 19.

The territory of this new parish includes the entire township of Belmont and the summer mission at Winnisquam. It may be necessary for you to live temporarily in the Rectory in Tilton if the house in Belmont is not vacated by that time.

The required oath and profession of faith may be taken at the Chancery Office any time at your convenience.

Praying God to grant you every grace in this new field of priestly endeavor, I remain.

February 19, 1949: Saint Joseph of Belmont until now a mission of Saint Mary of the Assumption, Tilton, Becomes officially a Parish with a mission in Winnisquam with Reverend Arthur L. Massicotte as its first Pastor. 130 families
